

NORTH FORK LEADERSHIP CENTER

Owned and operated by the Girl Scouts of Gateway Council, Inc.

- 250 acres
- Located just 10 miles SW of I-295 & SR21 (Blanding Blvd)
- Bordered by 1 mile on North Fork of Black Creek
- Can sleep up to 136 in two unique Camping "Villages"
- Located in a 911 emergency served area with good cell coverage



The Great Pasture

Large open fields bordered by the North fork of Black Creek and beautiful trees.

The Great Pasture is accessible by back pasture road providing for large day events and celebrations with plenty of field parking.



Health and Aquatics Center Swimming Pool & Edna Sproull Williams Training Center

Six Olympic lanes from 3' to 7' deep.

Rest Rooms and changing areas with outside rinse showers.

Sheltered area suitable for events, trainings, etc.

Zero depth "beach" entry for wheelchair and handicap access.



The Towers Family Activity Center

Located in the Fishing Village, The Towers Family Activity Center overlooks the North Fork of Black Creek.

Two floors of open space for meetings and activities. This facility is climate controlled and has a kitchen and two indoor bathrooms.

Sleeping is not allowed in the Activity Center.



Fishing Village Unit

This unit in the Fishing Village sleeps 24 in 3 cabins. Each unit is supported by a 24' X 26' **Program Shelter** for indoor activities and eating.

The Fishing Village has decking connecting all restrooms and cabins for ADA compliance.



Cabin Interior

Each of the seventeen cabins on campus sleeps eight, bunk-bed style. Ceiling fans and electrical outlets are in all cabins. Each cabin is 14' X 22' and has fire suppression sprinklers.



Lois T. Graessle Amphitheater

Features a unique design in the shape of the Girl Scout Trefoil. The Amphitheater seats 300 and has two fire pits on each side of the stage area.



Weaver and Maren Arts Village Activity Center

Located in the center of the Arts Village, this 40' X 55' building contains the **Publix Activity Room** - a 26' X 40' open space for activities, meetings or dining. The Activity Center also includes restrooms & showers.

A small kitchen is adjacent to this space which can be sub-divided in half with sliding barn doors. A large wrap-around porch also provides fun activity space. Tables and chairs are provided.



One of three **Program Shelters** located in the Arts Village.

This 24' X 30' building is ideal for activities, games or dining. It comes with a refrigerator, microwave, sink, cast iron skillets, tables and chairs. It is all screened with ceiling fans and sola-tubes for great natural lighting.

The rear of the building features a summer kitchen with a charcoal grill and outdoor sink/counter area.



Weaver Gazebo and Pond

Featured in a secluded area overlooking the largest of our four ponds. The Weaver Pond is also well stocked with fish. Canoe and kayak training are conducted here.



The **Oak Hammock** is a beautiful natural area where picnics and day events can occur.

This area is set off from the rest of the campus and is easily accessible from Lazy Acres Road.

Archery and horseshoes are just a few of the activities that can be conducted here.



The **Green Windmill** provides natural winddriven power for aeration in the pond near the Arts Village.



A **Low Ropes Challenge Course** has been developed around the North fork of Black Creek.

This course requires that a trained facilitator be present when using the elements.



The climbing wall is just one of the many featured elements in the Challenge Course.



Create your own adventure with canoes or kayaks on the North fork of Black Creek.

Almost a mile of creek front borders the **North Fork Leadership Center**, so you can stay close to the campus with a 20-30 minute paddle, or venture north into the Jennings Forrest if you are more adventurous.
